

French's Nursing Charity.

The French's Nursing Charity was set up in 1902 by the Rev. Frederic French the Rector of the parish, for the benefit of mothers following childbirth, who reside in the parishes of Worlingworth and Southolt.

The Ex-officio Trustees consist of the Rector, and Churchwardens of Worlingworth and a representative for Southolt. (vacant- looking for a new Trustee).

The charity has investments which generate income, although with relatively low returns in the present financial market.

Our aim is to make a modest gift of £25 to mothers on the birth of their babies.

We try to include every mother of a new born baby, who are residents of Worlingworth and Southolt, and we will try our best to reach everyone eligible.

We are a growing village with many new homes for families, so we often rely on the local news network to bring our attention to babies being born and getting their mother's contact details, which would be kept securely to comply with the data protection act.

We thank members of the public with the news of births, however there is a delay at the moment in making awards as new signatories need to be accepted by our Bank. Of the previous signatories one has died and another retired.
